**ORDINANCE No. 1 OF 2025**  
**CALENDAR YEAR 2025**

**ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK**

**(N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brigantine in the County of Atlantic finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2025 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that a 1% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$266,963.14 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Brigantine, in the County of Atlantic, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2025 budget year, the final appropriations of the City of Brigantine shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$934,370.99 and that the CY 2025 municipal budget for the City of Brigantine be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 284 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY

**WHEREAS**, implementing this Ordinance would be a benefit to the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the City of Brigantine and the individual who needs the use of said handicap space; and

**WHEREAS**, the space set forth in this Ordinance has been investigated by the Brigantine Police department who have recommended the same.

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
BRIGANTINE IN THE COUNTY OF ATLANTIC AND STATE OF NEW  
JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** Section 284-59 of the Code of the City of Brigantine shall be amended be adding the following space as a designated handicap space within the City of Brigantine:

LOCATION  
Twenty (20) foot area  
In front of the property  
located at 103 30<sup>th</sup> Street

**SECTION II:** Upon adoption by the City Council of the City of Brigantine of this Ordinance, the Department of Public Works and all other appropriate entities area authorized to take any and all steps to erect the appropriate signs designating the above space as a handicap parking space and to take any other action to fulfill the intention of this Ordinance.

**SECTION III:** Severability

If any section or part of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or illegal in any court or competent jurisdiction then said part is severable from this Ordinance as a whole and the remaining selections or parts of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION IV:** Repealer

All Ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said inconsistency.

**SECTION V:** Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication as prescribed by law.

Assisting local units in achieving unmet recreational obligations addresses these equity considerations, meeting the needs of communities that have been placed under substantial stress due to the lack of quality recreational facilities and spaces; and

**WHEREAS**, Local Recreation Improvement Grant funds will be allocated to each grant recipient to help cover costs associated with updating community centers, playgrounds, pools, fields, walking or bicycle trails, rail trails, multi-sport courts, and recreational facilities; one-time personnel costs directly related to improvements; project development professional services costs; equipment costs including playground and recreation facilities equipment; and environmental remediation costs required to prepare recreation sites for use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Recreation Improvement Grant (LRIG) exists to: Fund improvements to recreational facilities; Provide quality outdoor recreational space to underserved, communities, particularly in this time of heightened need; and assist local units in achieving unmet recreational obligations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brigantine strives to save tax dollars, assure clean land, air, and water, improve working and living environments; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brigantine wishes to apply for funding through the NJDCA Local Recreation Improvement Grant; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program ("State"), provides grants and/or loans to municipal and county governments and grants to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the acquisition, development, and stewardship of lands for outdoor recreation and conservation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brigantine desires to further the public interest by obtaining total funding in the amount of \$159,598.74, in the form of a \$478,796.23 matching grant to fund for the Brigantine Completely Inclusive Playground on East Shore Drive at a cost of \$638,394.47 (*total project cost*);

WHEREAS, the State shall determine if the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the Green Acres Program, and notify the applicant of the amount of the funding award; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the State's funds in accordance with such rules, regulations, and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the State for the above-named project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the governing body resolves that:

1. Mayor Vincent Sera or the successor to the office of Mayor is hereby authorized to:
  - a. make application for such a loan and/or such a grant,
  - b. provide additional application information and furnish such documents as may be required, and
  - c. act as the authorized correspondent of the above-named applicant;
2. The applicant agrees to provide its matching share to the Green Acres funding request, if a match is required, in the amount of \$159,598.74;
3. In the event the State's funds are less than the total project cost specified above, the applicant has the balance of funding necessary to complete the project;
4. The applicant agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in its performance of the project; and
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
