WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has approved that tax exemption from the date of January 12, 2026 and for subsequent years on the property known as Block 6902, Lot 41, recorded under the name(s) of Halsey D. Keats and Jennifer A. Keats,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brigantine that the taxes for the year 2026 from January 12, 2026 and subsequent years on the property known as Block 6902, Lot 41, and recorded under the name(s) of Halsey D. Keats and Jennifer A. Keats be and are hereby cancelled because he qualifies for an exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector of the City of Brigantine be and is hereby authorized to note said cancellation of the taxes on the total assessment of \$300,900 in the the Real Estate Tax Duplicate of the City of Brigantine from the date of January 12, 2026.



WHEREAS, the City of Brigantine received eight sealed bids and determined Charles Marandino, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder and;



**RESOLUTION GRANTING A REVOCABLE LICENSE AT 1312 WEST BEACH
AVENUE FOR AN ENCROACHMENT ON THE CITY'S PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, Susan Kennedy (the "Licensee") is the owner of Block 1502, Lot 9, commonly known as 1300 W. Beach Ave., Brigantine City, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the City recently purchase the land at 1312 W. Beach Avenue (the "Property") for the location of a new water well and associated drinking water systems; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the Property purchase a survey revealed that the Licensee's existing fence encroaches on the now City-owned Property by approximately thirteen feet (13') along the common property line; and

WHEREAS, upon notice of the encroachment and demand to remove the fence, the Licensee requested to purchase the land within the encroachment area; and

WHEREAS, the City is not yet in a position to make a determination as to whether the encroachment will impact the City's use of its Property, as thus, cannot make a determination under the Local Lands and Buildings Law (the "LLBL") whether the lands are no longer needed for a municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Licensee has now requested permission to use and maintain the fence located on a portion of the Property until such time as the City determines if it needs the lands for the water service engineering purposes or another municipal purpose or it will sell the lands under the LLBL; and

WHEREAS, the specific area is shown upon the July 28, 2025 plan prepared by Polistina & Associates, LLC, submitted with the Licensee's application; and

WHEREAS, the use of this area will not currently obstruct the City's intended use of the Property until the design of the water service system is finalized and approved by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer reviewed the application and plan and recommends approval of this temporary, revocable license agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to grant a revocable license to the Licensee subject to the execution of a License Agreement in recordable form prepared by the City Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Brigantine, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that:

- 1) The City grants a temporary, revocable license to Susan Kennedy for the purposes expressed herein; and
- 2) The City may, at its discretion, revoke the license should it determine that the use of the land is inconsistent with the application and/or creates a present or future health or safety concern.
- 3) As a condition of this approval, the Licensee shall not construct or locate any permanent or physical structure in the licensed area.
- 4) It is further conditioned that upon written notice or termination of the license, the Licensee shall have thirty (30) days to remove the encroachment and restore the lands to their natural condition and, upon failure to meet this requirement, the City may remove the encroachment at the cost of Licensee and without regard for the continued usability of the fence or other materials within the encroachment area.
- 5) The Mayor, City Manager, and City Clerk are authorized to execute any and all documents in furtherance of this Resolution upon review and approval of such documents by the City Solicitor's Office.


