

WATER AND SEWER Q&A

When is my water and sewer bill due?

Water: June 1 & December 1

Sewer: July 1 & January 1

*30 day grace period

Why is my June water bill higher than my December?

Water meters are read once a year and reflect in the June billing. December billing is a flat rate.

Am I paying my water/sewer bill in advance?

Yes, water/sewer is six (6) months prorated with the exception to the June water bill. The June water bill also includes any water excess from the prior year example: 3/01/15 – 3/01/16 excess period.

How could I use more water than last year?

Change in sprinkler cycles, worn out gaskets or faulty tank valves (flappers) in your toilets.

How can I have a leak if I don't hear water running?

Not all leaks can be heard or are visible. They may be underground or concealed.

Where can I find more information on my billing?

On the back of your bill or by calling the Tax Collectors Office

Can I pay my water, sewer and taxes online?

Yes, at www.bb-nj.org

Can I pay my water and sewer with one check?

Yes. For your convenience, and ours, one check is sufficient.

Can I pay water and sewer for the year, June/December & July/January?

Yes. For your convenience, and ours, one check is sufficient.
