Any Bid Addenda will also be issued on the City website, and processed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23(c)(1). All interested bidders should check the website from now through bid opening. It is the sole responsibility of the respondent to be knowledgeable of all addenda related to this procurement.

# CITY OF BRIGANTINE GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

#### 1. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- A. Sealed bids shall be received in accordance with public advertisement as required by law, a copy of said notice being attached hereto and made a part of these specifications.
- B. Each bid shall be submitted on the proposal form attached, in a sealed envelope:
  - 1. Addressed to the City of Brigantine, City Clerk
  - 2. Bearing the name and address of the bidder on the outside
  - 3. Clearly marked "BID" with the contract title.
- C. It is the bidder's responsibility to see that bids are presented to the City of Brigantine on the hour and at the place designated. Bids may be hand delivered or mailed; however, the City disclaims any responsibility for bids forwarded by regular or express mail. If the bid is sent by express mail, the designation in B. above must also appear on the outside of the express company envelope. Bids received after the designated time and date will be returned unopened.
- D. The City reserves the right to postpone the date for presentation and opening of bids and will give written notice of any such postponement to each perspective bidder as required by law.
- E. Sealed bids forwarded to the owner before the time of opening of bids may be withdrawn upon written application of the bidder who shall be required to produce evidence showing that the individual is or represents the principal or principals involved in the bid. Once bids have been opened, they shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) calendar days.
- F. Each bid proposal form must give the full business address, business phone, fax, e-mail, the contact person of the bidder, and be signed by an authorized representative as follow:
- Bids by partnerships must be signed in the partnership name by one of the members of the partnership or by an authorized representative followed by the signature and designation of the person signing.
- Bids by corporations must be signed in the legal name of the corporation, followed by the name of the State in which incorporated and must contain the signature and designation of the president, secretary or other person authorized to bind the corporation in the matter.
- Bids by sole-proprietorship shall be signed by the proprietor.
- When requested, satisfactory evidence of the authority of the officer signing shall be furnished.
- Each document in the bid proposal must be properly completed in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26H-6.5.
   No bidder shall submit the requested information on any form other than those provided in these bid specifications.

#### G. Multiple Bids Not Accepted

More than one bid from an individual, a firm or partnership, a corporation or association under the same or different names shall not be considered.

H. Official Request for Bid packages is available from the City's website at www.BB-NJ.org at no cost to the prospective bidders. All addenda are posted on the City site and issued in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23(c)(1). Potential bidders are cautioned that they are bidding at their own risk if a third party supplied the specifications that may or may not be complete. The City of Brigantine is not responsible for third party supplied specifications.

#### 2. BID SECURITY

The following provisions if indicated by an (X), shall be applicable to this bid and be made a part of the bid documents:

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Bidder shall submit with the bid a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total price bid, but not in excess of \$20,000, payable unconditionally to the City of Brigantine.

When submitting a Bid Bond, it shall contain Power of Attorney for full amount of Bid Bond from a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and acceptable to the City of Brigantine.

The check or bond of the unsuccessful bidder(s) shall be returned as prescribed by law. The check or bond of the bidder to whom the contract is awarded shall be retained until a contract is executed and the required performance bond or other security is submitted.

The check or bond of the successful bidder shall be forfeited if bidder fails to enter into contract pursuant to statute. Failure to submit required guarantee shall be cause for rejection of the bid.

### CONSENT OF SURETY

Bidder shall submit with the bid a Certificate (Consent of Surety) with Power of Attorney for full amount of bid price from a Surety Company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and acceptable to the City of Brigantine stating that it will provide said bidder to whom the contract is awarded will furnish Performance and Payment Bonds from an acceptable surety company on behalf of said bidder, in performance security equal to the total amount of the contract, pursuant to statute.

Failure to submit consent of surety form shall result in rejection of the bid.

## □ PERFORMANCE BOND

- A. The successful bidder, when awarded a contract, shall be required to furnish a performance bond/letter of credit in the full amount of the contract for the faithful performance of all provisions of the terms, conditions and specifications of the contract and their obligations there under. The bond shall be provided by an approved Surety Company authorized to transact business in the State of New Jersey.
- B. For a one (1) year contract, the successful bidder shall be required to provide a one (1) year performance bond issued by a Surety/Insurance Company in an amount equal to no more than one-hundred (100%) percent of the award price. The successful bidder shall provide said performance bond concurrent with the delivery of the executed contract to the City Clerk's office.
- C. Failure to provide the required one (1) year performance bond at the time and place specified by the City of Brigantine, shall be just cause for assessment of damages as a result thereof in accordance with Section E below. In the event that the successful bidder fails to provide said performance bond, the City of Brigantine may award the contract to the next lowest responsible bidder, or terminate the bid process and re-bid the collection service in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26h-67(d).
- D. For a multi-year contract, the successful bidder shall be required to provide a performance bond issued by a Surety/Insurance Company in an amount equal to no more than one-hundred (100%) percent of the annual value of the contract. The successful bidder shall provide said performance bond concurrent with the delivery of the executed contract to the City Clerk's Office, City of Brigantine, whose is located 1417 W. Brigantine Avenue, Brigantine NJ 08203. The performance bond for each succeeding year shall be delivered to the City of Brigantine with proof of full payment of the premium, one-hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the expiration of the current Performance Bond.

	E. Failure to deliver a performance bond for any year of a multi-year contract, one-hundred and twenty (120) days prior to the termination of the current performance bond shall constitute a breach of contract and shall entitle the City of Brigantine to terminate the contract upon the expiration of the current Performance Bond. Notwithstanding, termination pursuant to this section, the Contractor is obligated to fully perform through the date of termination of the contract and damages shall be assessed in an amount to the costs incurred by the City of Brigantine in rebidding the contract.
	LABOR AND MATERIAL (PAYMENT) BOND
	The successful bidder shall with the delivery of the performance bond submit an executed payment bond to guarantee payment to laborers and suppliers for the labor and material used in the work performed under the contract.
	Failure to submit a labor and material bond with the performance bond shall be cause for declaring the contract null and void.
	MAINTENANCE BOND
	Upon the acceptance of the work by the City, the contractor shall submit a maintenance bond (N.J.S.A. 40A:1-16.3) in the amount not to exceed 100% of the project costs guaranteeing against defective quality of work or materials for the period of:

3.	PREPARATION OF BIDS (PRICING INFORMATION AND FORMS)
	A. The City of Brigantine is exempt from any local, state or federal sales, use or excise tax. Brigantine will not pay for New Jersey State Sales and Use Tax that are included in any invoices. Brigantine City will not pay service charges such as interest and late fees.

- The City of Brigantine or any of its offices and divisions will not complete credit applications as a result of contract(s) resulting from award based on these specifications. The City is rated by Dun and Bradstreet.
- B. Bids must be <u>signed in ink</u> (original Signature required) by the bidder; all quotations shall be made with a typewriter / computer or pen and ink. Any quotation showing any erasure alteration must be initialed by the bidder in ink. Unit prices and totals are to be inserted in spaces provided.
- C. Failure to sign and give all information in the bid may result in the bid being rejected.
- D. <u>Estimated Quantities</u> (Open-End Contracts, Purchase as needed) The City has attempted to identify the item(s) and the estimated amounts of each item bid to cover it's requirements; however past experience shows that the amount ordered may be different than that submitted for bidding. The right is reserved to decrease or increase the quantities specified in the specifications pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.2 and 11.10. NO MINIMUM PURCHASE IS IMPLIED OR GUARANTEED.
- E. Bidders shall insert prices for furnishing goods and services required by these specifications. Prices shall be net including any charges for packing, crating, containers ect. All transportation charges fully prepaid by the contractor, F.O.B. destination and placement at locations specified by the City. No additional charges will be allowed for any transportation costs resulting from partial shipments made at vendors' convenience when a single shipment is ordered.
- F. Any bidder may withdraw his bid at any time before the time set for receipt of bids. No bid may be withdrawn in the 60 day period after the bids are received.
- G. All forms shall be completed and attached to the bid proposal. BIDDER IS ALERTED TO THE BID DOCUMENT CHECKLIST PAGE.

#### 4. FIRM FIXED CONTRACT

This is a firm fixed contract, prices firm, FOB City of Brigantine. No price escalation. The vendor shall void the contract and permit the City to solicit open market pricing should any price increase or surcharge be imposed.

#### 5. INTERPRETATION AND ADDENDA

- A. The bidder understands and agrees that its bid is submitted on the basis of the specifications prepared by the City. The bidder accepts the obligation to become familiar with these specifications.
- B. Bidders are expected to examine the specifications and related bid documents with care and observe all their requirements. Ambiguities, errors or omissions noted by bidders should be promptly reported in writing to the Purchasing Agent. In the event the bidder fails to notify the City of Brigantine of such ambiguities, errors or omissions, the bidder shall be bound by the bid.
- C. No oral interpretation of the meaning of the specifications will be made to any bidder. Every request for an interpretation shall be in writing, addressed to the City Purchasing Agent, referencing the Contract Name in the subject line. In order to be given consideration, written requests for interpretation and or clarification must be received at least (3) business days prior to the date fixed for the opening of the bids.
- D. All interpretations, clarifications and any supplemental instructions will be in the form of written addenda to the specifications, and will be distributed to all prospective bidders. All addenda so issued shall become part of the specification and bid documents, and shall be acknowledged by the bidder by completing the Acknowledgement of Receipt of Addenda form. The City's interpretations or corrections thereof shall be final.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23(c)(1) when issuing addenda, the owner shall provide required notice prior to official receipt of bids to any person who has submitted a bid or who has received a bid package. They will be sent via electronic transmissions to those known recipients of the bid specifications.

#### E. Discrepancies in Bids

- If the amount shown in words and its equivalent figures do not agree, the written words shall be binding. Ditto marks are not considered writing or printing and shall not be used.
- In the event that there is a discrepancy between the unit prices and the extended totals, the unit prices shall prevail. In the event there is an error of the summation of the extended totals, the computation by the City of the extended totals shall govern.

#### 6. BRAND NAMES, STANDARDS OF QUALITY AND PERFORMANCE

- A. Brand names and/or descriptions used in this bid are to acquaint bidders with the type of commodity desired and will be used as a standard by which alternate or competitive materials offered will be judged. Competitive items must be equal to the standard described and be of the same quality of work.
- B. Variations between the goods and services described and the goods and services offered are to be fully identified and explained by the bidder on a separate sheet and submitted with the bid proposal form. Vendor's literature <u>will not</u> suffice in explaining exceptions to these specifications. In the absence of any exceptions by the bidder, it will be presumed and required that materials as described in the proposal be delivered.
- C. It is the responsibility of the bidder to demonstrate the equivalency of the goods and services offered. The City reserves the right to evaluate the equivalency of a product which, in its deliberations, meets it requirements.
- D. In submitting its bid, the bidder certifies that the goods or services to be furnished will not infringe upon any valid patent or trademark and that the successful bidder shall, at its own expense, defend any and all actions or suits charging such infringement, and will save the City harmless from any damages resulting from such infringement.

- E. Only manufactured and farm products of the United States, wherever available, shall be used pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-18.
- F. Wherever practical and economical to the City of Brigantine, it is desired that recycled or recyclable products be provided. Please indicate when recycled products are being offered.
- G. The contractor shall guarantee any or all goods and services supplied under these specifications. Defective or inferior goods shall be replaced at the expense of the contractor. The contractor will be responsible for return freight or restocking charges.

#### 7. METHOD OF CONTRACT AWARD

- A. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive identified irregularities and technicalities, and to award in whole or in part to the lowest responsible bidder, if it is in the best interest of the City to do so. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, any bid which is incomplete, obscure, or irregular may be rejected, any bid having erasures or corrections in the price sheet may be rejected, any bid in which unit prices are omitted, or in which unit/total prices are unbalanced, may be rejected, any bid accompanied by any insufficient or irregular certified check, cashier's check or bid bond may be rejected.
- B. The City further reserves the right to award each item separately to the lowest responsible bidder meeting specifications or to make an award based on the total bid to the bidder whose total sum is the low bid meeting the specifications, whichever in the awarding authorities' opinion is in the best interest of the City. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the City reserves the right to award a contract based on either option that may be described in the bid proposal or based on any combination thereof.
- C. The City may also elect to award the contract on the basis of unit prices.
- D. The City reserves the right to award equal or tie bids at their discretion to any one of the tie bidders.
- E. Should the bidder, to whom the contract is awarded, fail to enter into a contract, the City may then, at its option, accept the bid of the next lowest responsible bidder.
- F. The contract shall be awarded or all bids rejected within sixty (60) days of the public opening of the bid proposals, unless an extension of additional time has been granted by the lowest responsible bidder
- G. The successful bidder shall be required to execute the contract and furnish the needed performance bond, as stated in Section 2 of this bid document, within <u>fourteen (14) calendar days</u> after the award of the contract by the City Council of Brigantine.
- H. The effective period of this contract will be three years with two option years unless otherwise noted in the specifications. Continuation of the terms of this contract beyond the calendar year is contingent on availability of funds in the following year's budget. In the event of unavailability of such funds, the City reserves the right to cancel this contract.
- The form contract shall be submitted by the City to the successful bidder. Terms of the specifications/bid package prevail. Bidder exceptions must be formally accepted by the City; material exceptions shall not be approved.
- J. Government entities are not private business/consumer clients; therefore, separate company agreements are not honored. Terms of the specifications/bid package prevail unless otherwise noted by the vendor as exceptions.

#### 8. CAUSES FOR REJECTING BIDS

Bids may be rejected for any of the following reasons:

- A. All bids pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2;
- B. If more than one bid is received from an individual, firm or partnership, corporation or association under the same name;
- C. Multiple bids from an agent representing competing bidders:
- D. The bid is inappropriately unbalanced;
- E. If the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract within 21 days, Sundays and holidays excepted, or as otherwise agreed upon by the parties to the contract. In this case at its option, the City may accept the bid of the next lowest responsible bidder. (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-24b)

# 9. NEW JERSEY PREVAILING WAGE ACT (When Applicable) N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq., it is declared to be the public policy of this State to establish a prevailing wage level for workmen engaged in public works in order to safeguard their efficiency and general wellbeing and to protect them as well as their employers from the effects of serious and unfair competition resulting from wage levels detrimental to efficiency and well-being.

The Contractor and any subcontractor thereof engaged under a contract pursuant to this specification is subject to and shall comply with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 34:11-68 with respect to record keeping of all individuals engaged in the collection or transportation of solid waste or recyclable material, excluding recycled or reclaimed asphalt or concrete, collected under this contract as follows:

The Contractor or subcontractor shall submit a certified payroll record showing only the name, the actual hourly rate of wages paid to, and the actual daily, overtime and weekly hours worked by each individual engaged in the collection and transportation work done under the contract, in a form satisfactory to the City of Brigantine's Director of Public Works, for each payroll period not more than ten (10) days after the payment of wages. Reporting under this section may be fulfilled by using the New Jersey Department of Labor & Workforce Development's "Payroll Certification for Public Works Project" and completing columns 1-5 for each covered employee. The certifications shall be submitted to the City Purchasing Agent.

By entering into a contract, the Contractor acknowledges the provisions of N.J.S.A. 34:11-68 with regard to the authority of the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development to investigate the Contractor or subcontractor's wages and any penalties that may result from failure to comply. When applicable payrolls shall be required and noncompliance of this requirement will be cause for delay in the process of payments.

# 10. THE PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACTORS REGISTRATION ACT N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 et seq.

N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.48 et seq. requires that a general or prime contractor and any listed subcontractors named in the contractor's bid proposal shall possess a certificate at the time the bid proposal is submitted. After bid Proposals are received and prior to award of contract, the successful contractor shall submit a copy of the contractor's certification along with those of all listed subcontractors. All non-listed subcontractors and lower tier sub-subcontractors shall be registered prior to starting work on the project. It is the general contractor's responsibility that all non-listed sub-contractors at any tier have their certificate prior to starting work on the job.

Under the law a "contractor" is "a person, partnership, association, joint stock company, trust, corporation or other legal business entity or successor thereof who enters into a contract" which is subject to the provisions of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq.). It applies to contractors based in New Jersey or in another state.

The law defines "public works projects" as contract for "public work" as defined in the Prevailing Wage statute (N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25(5)). The term means:

- "Construction, reconstruction, demolition, alteration, or repair work, or maintenance work, including painting and decorating, done under contract and paid for in whole or in part out of the funds of a public body, except work 1performed under a rehabilitation program.
- "Public Work" shall also mean construction, reconstruction, demolition, alteration, or repair work, done on any property or premises, whether or not the work is paid for from public funds..."
- "Maintenance work" means the repair of existing facilities when the size, type or extent of such facilities
  is not thereby changed or increased. While "maintenance" includes painting and decorating and is
  covered under the law, it does not include work such as routine landscape maintenance or janitorial
  services.

To register, a contractor must provide the State Department of labor and Workforce Development with a full and accurately completed application form. The form is available online at: http://lwd.state.nj.us/labor/wagehour/regperm/pw cont reg.html

N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.55 specifically prohibits accepting applications for registration as a substitute for a certificate or registration.

#### 11. NON-COLLUSION AFFIDAVIT - N.J.S.A. 52:34-15

The Non-Collusion Affidavit, which is part of these specifications, shall be properly executed and submitted intact with the proposal.

#### 12. NEW JERSEY ANTI-DISCRIMINATION - N.J.S.A. 10:2-1

There shall be no discrimination against any employee engaged in the work required to produce the goods and services covered by any contract resulting from this bid, or against any applicant to such employment because of race, religion, sex, national origin, creed, color, ancestry, age, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, familial status, liability for service in the Armed Forces of the United States, or nationality. This provision shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment upgrading, demotion, transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, layoff or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor shall insert a similar provision in all subcontracts for services to be covered by any contract resulting from this bid.

# 13. MANDATORY EEO / AFFIRMATIVE ACTION EVIDENCE N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17-27 et seq.

No firm may be issued a contract unless it complies with the affirmative action provisions of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-1 et seq. as administered by the Division of Purchase & Property Contract Compliance and Audit Unit (Division) and provided below. The contract will include the language included as attachment A in this specification.

#### 1. Goods, Professional Services and Service Contracts

Each contractor shall submit to the public agency, after notification of award but prior to execution of a goods and services contract, one of the following three documents:

- i. A Letter of Federal Approval indicating that the vendor is under an existing federally approved or sanctioned affirmative action program. A copy of the letter must be provided by the vendor to the Public Agency and Division. This approval letter is valid for one year from the date of issuance.
- ii. A Certificate of Employee Information Report (hereafter "Certificate"), issued in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27 et seq. The vendor must provide a copy of the Certificate to the Public Agency as evidence of its compliance with the regulations. The Certificate represents the review and approval of the vendor's Employee Information Report, Form AA-302 by the Division
- iii. The successful bidder shall complete an Initial Employee Report, Form AA-302 and submit it to the Division with a check or money order for \$150.00 made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Jersey" www.state.nj.us/treasury/contract\_compliance

#### 2. Construction Contracts

All successful contractors shall complete and submit an Initial Project Manning Report (AA201-available on-line at www.state.nj.us/treasury/contract\_compliance upon notification of award. Proper completion and submission of this Report shall constitute evidence of the contractor's compliance with the regulations. Failure to submit this form may result in the contract being terminated. The contractor also agrees to submit a copy of the Monthly Project Workforce Report, Form AA-202 once a month thereafter for the duration of the contract to the Department of LWD and to the Public Agency.

#### 14. AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990 - 42 U.S.C. S121 01 et seq.

Discrimination on the basis of disability in contracting for the purchase of goods and services is prohibited. Bidders are required to read Americans with Disabilities language that is included in this specification and agree that the provisions of Title II of the Act are made a part of the contract. The contractor is obligated to comply with the Act and to hold the City harmless.

#### 15. WORKER AND COMMUNITY RIGHT TO KNOW ACT - N.J.S.A. 34:5A-1 et seq.

The manufacturer or supplier of chemical substances or mixtures shall label them in accordance with the N.J. Worker and Community Right to Know Law (N.J.S.A. 34: 51 et seq., and N.J.A.C 5:89-5 et seq.).

All direct use containers shall bear a label indicating the chemical name(s) and Chemical Abstracts Service number(s) of all hazardous substances in the container, and all other substances which are among the five most predominant substances in the container, or their trade secret registry number(s). (N.J.A.C. 8:59-5) or adhere to the requirements of The Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS) and the U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Hazard Communication Standard (HCS) as outlined in the Federal Register / Vol. 77, No. 58 / Monday, March 26, 2012 / Rules and Regulations as adopted in the final rule by DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, Occupational Safety and Health Administration, 29 CFR Parts 1910, 1915, and 1926, {Docket No. OSHA-H022K-2006-0062, (formerly Docket No. H022K)}, RIN 1218-AC20, Hazard Communication. Further, all applicable documentation must be furnished.

#### STATEMENT OF CORPORATE OWNERSHIP – N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 (P.L. 1977 c.33)

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2, no corporation, partnership, limited partnership, limited liability corporation, limited liability partnership, Subchapter S corporation or sole proprietorship, shall be awarded a contract, unless prior to the receipt of the bid or accompanying the bid for the corporation, partnership, limited partnership, there is submitted to the City a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders who own 10% or more of the stock, of any class or of all individual partners who own a 10% or greater interest in the corporation, partnership. Limited partnership, limited liability corporation, limited liability partnership, Subchapter S corporation or sole proprietorship. If one or more such stockholder or partner is itself a corporation or partnership, the stockholders holding 10% or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning 10% or greater interest in that partnership, as the case may be, shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every non-corporate stockholder and individual partner, exceeding the 10% ownership criteria established in this act has been listed. This form shall be signed and submitted with

the bid/proposal whether or not a stockholder or partner owns less than 10% of the business submitting the bid. Failure to comply requires mandatory rejection of the bid/proposal.

#### 17. INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION

If it becomes necessary for the contractor, either as principal or by agent or employee, to enter upon the premises or property of the owner in order to construct, erect, inspect, make delivery or remove property hereunder, the contractor hereby covenants and agrees to take use, provide and make all proper, necessary and sufficient precautions, safeguards, and protection against the occurrence of happenings of any accident, injuries, damages, or hurt to person or property during the course of the work herein covered and be his/her sole responsibility.

The contractor further covenants and agrees to indemnify and save harmless the owner from the payment of all sums of money or any other consideration(s) by reason of any, or all, such accidents, injuries, damages, or hurt that may happen or occur upon or about such work and all fines, penalties and loss occurred for or by reason of the violation of any owner regulation, ordinance or the laws of the State, or the United States while said work is in progress.

The contractor shall maintain sufficient insurance to protect against all claims under Workers Compensation, General Liability and Automobile and shall be subject to approval for adequacy of protection and certificates of such insurance shall be provided with the owner named as additional insured.

#### A. Insurance Requirements

#### Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance

Workers Compensation insurance shall be maintained in full force during the life of the contract, covering all employees engaged in performance of the contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 34:15-12(a) and N.J.A.C. 12:235-1.6. Statutory coverage, including employer's liability coverage.

#### **General Liability Insurance**

This insurance shall have limits of not less than \$3,000,000.00 each occurrence and \$3,000,000.00 aggregate products and completed operations shall be maintained in force during the life of the contract.

#### Automobile Liability Insurance

This insurance covering bidder for claims arising from owned, hired and non-owned vehicles with limits of not less than \$3,000,000.00 each occurrence shall be maintained in force during the life of this contract by the bidder.

Environmental impairment or \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit pollution exclusion clause referring back to the general liability insurance

#### B. Certificates of the Required Insurance

Certificates as listed above shall be submitted along with the contract as evidence covering Comprehensive General Liability, Comprehensive Automobile Liability, and where applicable, necessary Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance. Such coverage shall be with acceptable insurance companies operating on an admitted basis in the State of New Jersey and shall name the OWNER as an additional insured.

Self-insured contractors shall submit an affidavit attesting to their self-insured coverage and shall name the OWNER as an additional insured.

#### C. Indemnification

The Contractor agrees to indemnify and save harmless the City, its officers, agents and employees, from all claims, suits or actions, and damages or costs of every name and description to which the owner may be subjected or put by reason of injury to the person or property of another, or the property of the owner, resulting from:

- negligent acts or missions on the part of the contractor, the contractor's agents, servants or subcontractors in the delivery of goods and services, or in the performance of the work under the contract; and,
- the use of any copyrighted or copyrighted composition, valid trademark, secret process, patented or unpatented invention or article furnished or used in the performance of this contract.

The City of Brigantine will not accept Mutual Limitation of Liability terms.

#### 18. PAYMENT

Payment shall be made after a properly executed City voucher has been received and formally approved on the bill list by the City Council at its subsequent regular meeting. The voucher will be certified correct by the department/division head who received the goods or services.

#### 19. TERMINATION

- A. If, through any cause, the contractor shall fail to fulfill in a timely manner obligations under the contract or if the contractor shall violate any of the requirements of the contract, the City shall there upon have the right to terminate the contract by giving written notice to the contractor of such termination and specifying the effective date of termination. Such termination shall relieve the City of any obligation for balances to the contractor of any sum or sums set forth in the contract. The City of Brigantine will pay for goods and services accepted prior to termination.
- B. Notwithstanding the above, the contractor shall not be relieved of liability to the City for damages sustained by the City by virtue of any breach of the contract by the contractor and the City may withhold any payments to the contractor for the purpose of compensation until such time as the exact amount of the damage due the City from the contractor is determined.
- C. The contractor agrees to indemnify and hold the City harmless from any liability to subcontractors/suppliers concerning payment for work performed or goods supplied arising out of the lawful termination of the contract by the City under this provision.
- D. In case of default by the contractor, the City may procure the goods and services from other sources and hold the contractor responsible for any excess cost.
- E. Continuation of the terms of the contract beyond the calendar year is contingent on availability of funds in the following year's budget. In the event of unavailability of such funds, the City reserves the right to cancel the contract.
- F. It is understood by all parties that if, during the life of the contract, the contractor disposes of his/her business concern by acquisition, merger, sale and/or transfer or by any means convey his/her interest(s) to another party, all obligations are transferred to the new party. In this event, the new owner(s) will be required to submit all documentation/legal instruments that were required in the original bid/contract. Any changes shall be approved by the City.
- G. The contractor will not assign any interest in the contract and shall not transfer any interest in the same without the prior written consent of the City.
- H. The City may terminate the contract for convenience by providing sixty (60) calendar days advanced notice to the contractor.

- I. The contractor shall maintain all documentation related to products, transactions or services under this contract for a period of five years from the date of final payment. Such records shall be available to the New Jersey Office of the State Comptroller upon request.
- J. For contracts that exceed one year, each calendar year payment obligation of the City is conditioned upon the availability of the City of Brigantine funds appropriated or allocated for the payment of such an obligation. If funds are not allocated and available for the continuance of any services performed by the bidder awarded the contract (contractor) hereunder, whether in whole or in part, the City at the end of any particular calendar year may terminate such services. The City will notify the contractor in writing immediately of any services that will be affected by a shortage of appropriated funds. This provision shall not be construed so as to permit the City to terminate the contract during the term, or any service hereunder, merely in order to acquire identical services from another contractor.
- K. Neither party shall be responsible for any resulting loss or obligation to fulfill duties as specified in any of the terms or provisions of a contract if the fulfillment of any term or provision of the contract is delayed or prevented by any revolutions, insurrections, riots, wars, acts of enemies, national emergencies, strikes, floods, fires, acts of God, or by any cause not within the control of the party whose performance is interfered with which by the exercise of reasonable diligence such party is unable to prevent. Additionally, if the fulfillment of any of the terms and provisions of the contract is delayed or prevented by any court order, or action or injunction or other such agreement, the contract shall become voidable by the City of Brigantine by notice to the parties.

## 20. ACQUISITION, MERGER, SALE AND/OR TRANSFER OF BUSINESS, ETC.

It is understood by all parties that if, during the life of the contract, the contractor disposes of his/her business concern by acquisition, merger, sale and or/transfer or by any means convey his/her interest(s) to another party, all obligations are transferred to that new party. In this event, the new owner(s) will be required to submit, when required, a performance bond in the amount of the open balance of the contract.

#### 21. ADDITIONS / DELETIONS OF SERVICE

The City reserves the right to add and/or delete services to this contract. Should a service requirement be deleted, payment to the Contractor will be reduced proportionally to the amount of service deleted in accordance with the bid price. Should additional services be required, payment to the Contractor will be increased proportionally to the amount of service added in accordance with the bid price.

- 22. Vendor's literature and/or pricing sheets will not be accepted in lieu of completing the proposal blank(s) set forth in these specifications.
- 23. Bidders shall not write in margins or alter the official content or requirements of the City bid documents.

#### 24. SPECIFICATIONS

Any prospective bidder who wishes to challenge a bid specification shall file such challenges in writing with the contracting agent no less than three business days prior to the opening of the bids. Challenges filed after that time shall be considered void and having no impact on the contracting unit or the award of contract.

#### 25. OWNERSHIP OF MATERIAL

The owner shall retain all of its rights and interest in any and all documents and property both hard copy and digital furnished by the owner to the contractor for the purpose of assisting the contractor in the performance of this contract. All such items shall be returned immediately to the owner at the expiration or termination of the contract or completion of any related services, pursuant thereto, whichever comes first. None of the documents and/or property shall, without the written consent of the owner, be disclosed to others or used by the contractor

or permitted by the contractor to be used by their parties at any time except in the performance of the resulting contract.

Ownership of all data, materials and documentation originated and prepared for the owner pursuant to this contract shall belong exclusively to the owner. All data, reports, computerized information, programs and materials related to this project shall be delivered to and become the property of the owner upon completion of the project. The contractor shall not have the right to use, sell, or disclose the total of the interim or final work products, or make available to third parties, without the prior written consent of the owner.

#### 26. TRUTH IN CONTRACTING LAW

- N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34, et seq. governs false claims and representation. It is a serious crime for the bidder to knowingly submit a false claim and/or knowingly make material misrepresentation.
- N.J.S.A. 2C:27-10 provides that a person commits a crime if said person offers a benefit to a public servant for an official act performed or to be performed by a public servant, which is a violation of official duty.
- N.J.S.A. 2C:27-11 provides that a bidder commits a crime if said person, directly or indirectly, confers or
  agrees to confer any benefit not allowed by law to a public servant.
- Bidder should consult the statutes or legal counsel for further information.

#### 27. PROOF OF NEW JERSEY BUSINESS REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE N.J.S.A. 52:32-44

Each bidder (contractor) is required to submit proof of business registration prior to award of the contract. Proof of registration shall be a copy of the bidder's Business Registration Certificate (BRC).

N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 imposes the following requirements on contractors and all subcontractors that knowingly provide goods or perform services for a contractor fulfilling this contract:

- The contractor shall obtain and provide the owner the BRC of subcontractors knowingly used on this contract.
- 2. The contractor shall maintain and submit to the contracting agency a list of subcontractor's and their addresses that may be updated from time to time during the course of the contract performance. A complete and accurate list shall be submitted before final payment is made for goods and services rendered under the contract.
- 3. During the term of this contract, the contractor and its affiliates shall collect and remit, and shall notify all subcontractors and their affiliates that they must collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act, (N.J.S.A. 54:32B-1 et seq.) on all taxable sales of tangible personal property delivered into the State.

Failure to submit the BRC with the bid is *NOT* a cause for rejection. However, the City prefers the BRC be submitted with the bid response. If it is not provided prior to execution of a contract the bidder's bid guarantee shall be forfeited and the contract shall be awarded to the next lowest responsible bidder.

A contractor, subcontractor or supplier who fails to provide proof of business registration or provides false business registration information shall be liable to a penalty of \$25.00 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000 for each business registration not properly provided or maintained under a contract with a contracting agency.

A BRC is obtained from the New Jersey Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services. Information on obtaining a BRC is available on the internet at www.nj.gov/treasury/revenue/busregcert.shtml or by phone at (609) 292-2929.

#### 28. PAY TO PLAY - NOTICE OF DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENT

Business entities are advised of their responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement of political contributions with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27 if they receive contracts in excess of \$50,000 from public entities in a calendar year. Business entities are responsible for determining if filing is necessary. Additional information on this requirement is available from ELEC at 888-313-3532 or at www.elec.state.nj.us.

#### 29. NON-PAYMENT OF PENALTIES AND INTEREST ON OVERDUE BILLS

Public funds may be used to pay only for goods delivered or services rendered. The City of Brigantine will not pay penalties and/or interest on overdue bills. No employee is authorized to sign a letter of credit or any other document that represents a legal commitment on the part of the City to pay additional fees.

#### 30. W-9

Successful bidder/respondent shall complete W-9 Form and submit to purchasing prior to contract award. The form is available at the following link: www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/fw9.pdf

#### 31. HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 1996-HIPAA (If Applicable)

Both parties agree to comply with all requirements of the Federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 ("HIPAA") as maybe amended from time to time, and the corresponding HIPAA regulations for the confidentiality and security of medical information.

The Contractor shall:

- Not use or disclose protected health information other than as permitted or required by law
- Use appropriate safeguards to protect the confidentiality of the information
- Report any use or disclosure not permitted

The contractor, by execution of the contract, shall thereby indemnify and hold the City harmless from any and all liabilities, claims, actions, costs and penalties which may be incurred as the result of the failure of the contractor to comply with the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) or any other statute or case law protecting the privacy of persons using its services.

#### 32. PUBLIC EMERGENCY

In the event of a Public Emergency declared at the Local, State or Federal Level, if the City opts to extend terms and conditions of this bid, the contractor agrees to extend the terms and conditions of this bid, whether existing, expiring or expired no longer than six months, for goods and/or services for the duration of the emergency. In the event the original contractor cannot meet this requirement, the City may solicit the goods and/or services from any bidder on this contract.

- 33. The owner and the Contractor each bind themselves and their successors, executors, administrators, heirs and assigns and legal representatives of the other party respecting all covenants and agreements and obligations of this contract.
- **34.** The terms of this Agreement shall be construed and interpreted, and all respective rights and duties of the parties shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.

#### 35. NEW JERSEY DIESEL RETROFIT LAW

Whereas, the New Jersey Retrofit Law (N.J.S.A. 26:2C-8.26) was passed on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2005, requiring all solid waste collection vehicles with engines manufactured <u>prior to 2007</u> that are publically owned or utilized to perform solid waste collection services under a public contract to be retrofitted to control diesel emissions. In addition, publically-owned recycling collection vehicles with engines manufactured prior to 2007 (but not privately owned ones that are utilized in public contracts) are covered by the Diesel Retrofit Law and shall be retrofitted. See www.stopthesoot.org for further information. In lieu of retrofitting their vehicles, solid waste and recycling haulers can comply with the Law by replacing their older vehicles with 2010 or newer diesel vehicles or vehicles powered by gasoline, propane, natural gas or electric.

All collection vehicles utilized in connection with this contract shall be required to be listed and a copy of said list shall be supplied with the bid proposal submission. Further, it shall be noted as to which vehicles have been retrofitted and/or exempt under the Diesel Retrofit Law. Additionally, a copy of the compliance form issued pursuant to N.J.S.A. 7:27-32.20 (Diesel Retrofit Law – Issuance & Completion of Compliance Forms) for each vehicle to be utilized in the execution of the terms of this contract. The Contractor shall ensure at all times that any vehicle utilized in the execution of this contract is in compliance with the Diesel Retrofit Law (N.J.S.A. 26:2C-8), and inspection requirements and idling limits set forth at N.J.S.A. 7:27-14.

#### 35. DISCLOSURE OF INVESTMENT ACTIVITIES IN IRAN

P.L. 2012, c.25 prohibits State and local public contracts with persons or entities engaging in certain investment activities in energy or finance sectors of Iran.

#### DISPOSAL SERVICES FOR RECYCLING MATERIAL AND SOLID WASTE CONTAINERS

#### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

All bid proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud by the City of Brigantine on Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 11:00 A.M.

The work of this contract shall include the rental, collection, hauling, and disposal of various size solid waste containers for different locations throughout the City of Brigantine for a <u>period of three (3) years with two (2) option years</u>, to commence on <u>November 13, 2018</u>. The continuous performance of this service and work without any interruption is essential and a primary requirement of this contract.

Each document in the bid proposal must be properly completed in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26H-6.5. No bidder shall submit the requested information on any form other than those provided in these bid specifications.

The successful contractor shall furnish all labor, material and equipment required for the collection, removal and transfer of all assigned waste, which may be produced within the boundary limits of the City of Brigantine in accordance with the methods, requirements and procedures hereafter specified and as set forth in the contract.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

- "Bid Proposal" means all documents, bid proposal forms, affidavits, certificates, statements required to be submitted by the bidder at the time of the bid opening.
- "Bid Guarantee" means the bid bond, cashier's check or certified check submitted as part of the bid proposal, payable to the contracting unit, ensuring that the successful bidder will enter into a contract.
- "Bid Specifications" means all documents requesting bid proposals for municipal solid waste collection services contained herein.
- "Certificate of Insurance" means a document showing that an insurance policy has been written and includes a statement of the coverage of the policy.
- "Collection Site" means the location of waste containers on collection day.
- "Collection Source" means a generator of designated collected solid waste to whom service will be provided under the contract.
- "Consent of Surety" means a promissory note guaranteeing that if the contract is awarded, the surety will provide a performance bond.
- "Contract" means the written agreement executed by and between the successful bidder and the governing body and shall include the bid proposal, and the bid specifications.
- "Contract Administrator" is the person authorized by the contracting unit to procure and administer contracts for solid waste collection services.
- "Contracting Unit" means the municipality of any board, commission, committee, authority or agency, and which has administrative jurisdiction over any district other than a school district, project, or facility, included or operating in whole or in part, within the territorial boundaries of any county or municipality which exercises functions where are appropriate for the exercise by one or more units of local government, and which has statutory power to make purchases and enter into contracts or agreements for the performance of any work of the furnishing or hiring of any materials or supplies usually required, the costs or contact price of which is to be paid with or out of public funds.

- Yard Waste (Grass Clippings, Leaves, Christmas Trees, Tree Trimmings & Branches)
- White Goods
- Tires
- Scrap Metal
- Controlled Electronic Devices (CEDs), Computers, Laptop, Monitors & Televisions

"Designated Collected Solid Waste" Solid waste types #10. Designated collected solid waste shall not consist of recyclable materials, hazardous waste or solid animal and vegetable wastes

"Disposal Facility" Those sites designated in the Atlantic County Solid Waste Management Plan for use by the City of Brigantine. The current disposal facility that will accept the types of wastes that will be collected pursuant to this contract is listed below:

Atlantic County Utilities Authority (ACUA) 6700 Delilah Road Egg Harbor Township NJ 08234

"Governing Body" means the governing body of the municipality, when the contract or agreement is to be entered into by, or on behalf of a municipality as further defined at N.J.A.C. 40A:11-2.

"Holiday" means a regularly scheduled collection day on which the authorized disposal facilities are closed, which is either the actual holiday or the Federal legal holiday to include:

New Years Day (January 1<sup>st</sup>) Thanksgiving Day (4<sup>th</sup> Thursday in November) Christmas Day (December 25<sup>th</sup>)

"Bid Proposal Form(s)" means those forms that must be used by all bidders to set forth the prices for services to be provided under the contract.

"Pull" means the servicing of a container and may include but not limited to; rental, transporting, dumping, and returning of a container depending on the specifications of each referenced section here in.

"Surety" means a company that is duly certified to do business in the State of New Jersey and that is qualified to issue bonds in the amount and of the type and character required by these specifications. Service Area: The Superintendent of Public Works will assign areas where containers are to be placed.

#### **DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED**

- Certified photocopies of bidder's certificate of public convenience and necessity and an approved letter issued in conformance with N.J.S.A. 13:1E-126;
- Questionnaire setting forth experience and qualifications
- Bid Guarantee in the form of a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check in the amount of ten (10%)
  percent of the total amount of the bid proposal, not to exceed \$20,000.00; payable to the City of
  Brigantine
- Non-Collusion Affidavit Form
- Statement of Ownership Disclosure Form
- Certificate of Surety
- Bid proposal & bid proposal form(s)

All of the foregoing shall be submitted in accordance with the instructions of these specifications. The division of the contract specification into parts is merely for convenience and ready reference; all parts of the specification constitute a single document.

#### **BID PROPOSAL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

In addition to the provisions previously stated, an experience and equipment statement prepared in an appropriate report format that establishes and sets forth the following items shall accompany the bid proposal:

- Proof of having a business engaged in the solid waste and/or recycling industry for a minimum of five (5) years.
- Proof of any similar contracts, either private or public in nature, fully completed or currently in force.
- Proof of providing solid waste containerized collection services to local governments, or other governmental entities.

The submission of a proposal for this work shall be considered as a representation that the bidder has carefully and completely investigated all relevant and material conditions which affect, or may at some future date, affect the performance of the work or services covered by the proposal, and the entire area to be serviced: and the submission of a proposal for this work shall clearly indicate that the bidder is fully informed and aware of conditions to be encountered regarding the character, quality, and quantity of work necessary to properly perform this contract, and personnel, equipment, material, and supplies needed to carry out the specifications of this agreement.

Bid amounts submitted on the Bid Proposal Form(s) shall be for the first year of the contract only. Increases in each subsequent year shall be based on the advertised October Philadelphia Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) in the year prior to the beginning of each contract year capped at three (3%) percent. For example, the increase for the contract year 2019 (November 13, 2019 thru October 12, 2020) shall be based on the advertised 2018 October Philadelphia CPI-U. The lesser of the two shall be utilized to calculate the actual percentage increase amount for each subsequent contract year. Only the Department of Labor advertised Philadelphia CPI-U can be utilized for an increase, no other calculations shall be acceptable to the City.

The submission of a bid proposal for this work shall indicate that the bidder is sufficiently familiar and aware of all applicable Federal, State, County, and local laws, codes, regulations and ordinances which in any way affect the execution of the work or persons engaged or employed in the work or the materials and equipment used in the execution of this work.

The Contractor shall protect and indemnify the City of Brigantine and its employees or agents against any and all claims of liability arising from or based on the violations of any above stated laws, regulations, or ordinances, whether committed by the bidder or their employees, agents or authorized representatives.

A <u>Pre-bid Meeting</u> concerning the Bid Specifications for Disposal Service for Recycling Material and Solid Waste Containerized Services will be held on <u>Thursday, September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018 @ 2:00 P.M.</u> in the Conference Room. City Hall is located at 1417 W. Brigantine Avenue, Brigantine NJ 08203. The Pre-bid Meeting is open to all interested vendors. The Pre-bid Meeting is voluntary however the City strongly encourages all potential bidders to attend. Ample opportunity will be provided for all vendors to ask questions regarding the specifications for the Collection and Disposal Service for Recycling Material and Solid Waste Containers.

#### MATTER TO BE COLLECTED

The Contractor will be required to remove various size dumpsters to the Atlantic County Transfer Facility and/or other destinations as directed then return them to their original location.

#### **COLLECTION SCHEDULE**

Dumpsters will be removed on a demand basis. The City will notify the contractor when the service is needed.

#### PAYMENT SCHEDULE

The Contractor shall furnish monthly billing(s) to the City so that payment can be processed.

The monthly invoice shall include the number of containers disposed of during the time period, any special or extra charges along with sufficient justification for the special charges incurred during the time period, and the total cost of this solid waste collection service for the month.

No additional compensation, beyond the amount specified in the bid, shall be granted for any increase in amount of collection or services due to seasonal variations.

#### VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT

All vehicles and equipment utilized by the Contractor shall be legally registered with, and comply with applicable requirements of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Laws.

All vehicles and equipment utilized by the Contractor shall be legally registered with, and comply with the requirements of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26-3.1 et seg.

The Contractor is fully responsible for any public or private damage that occurs as a result of the performance of this contract.

All containers, equipment, and vehicles shall be maintained in good working order and shall be constructed, used and maintained so as to reduce unnecessary noise, spillage, and odors.

All vehicles shall be equipped with a broom and shovel, at a minimum.

The Contractor shall be responsible for all cost of equipment maintenance, insurance, fuel, oils, lubricants, parts and required service.

Extra equipment shall be available at all times to replace vehicles requiring maintenance and/or repair.

Prior to the signing of the contract, the Contractor shall furnish the City of Brigantine with the following information on all vehicles/equipment used in the execution of this contract:

- The year
- The make or manufacturer
- The model & model number, if applicable
- State license plate number
- The cubic size of solid waste capacity
- The type of vehicle rear load or roll-off

The City shall have the right to inspect all vehicles and equipment, at any time, during the term of this contract. The Contractor shall comply with any and all reasonable requests relative to the maintenance and repair of said vehicles and equipment used in the execution of this contract.

The Contractor shall not substitute containers, vehicles, or equipment except in an emergency where designated containers, vehicles or equipment are unavailable due to breakdown or under repair. The substitution shall be reasonably minimized and limited to the duration of the breakdown or repair.

The Contractor shall notify the City, in writing, providing previously stated information upon the acquisition of any new vehicle/equipment to their fleet.

Failure to comply with these provisions after the receipt of <u>one (1) written warning</u> from the City shall constitute just cause for the termination of the contract, and the performance bond for continuation of collection services may be invoked.

#### MATERIAL EXCLUDED FROM COLLECTION & DISPOSAL

The following material shall be excluded from collection and disposal under this contract:

- Abandoned vehicles, vehicle batteries, paint, used motor oil, or any other material defined as hazardous by the State of New Jersey and/or the Atlantic County Utilities Authority.
- Medical waste.
- Construction and demolition debris generated from residential and commercial properties.

#### A.C.U.A. DISPOSAL FINES & SURCHARGES

The Contractor shall pay for any increases in the disposal cost, where it is borne by the Contractor, as a result of actions by State and/or County regulatory agencies having jurisdiction over this matter, unless clearly stated otherwise in the specifications.

Financial fines or penalties as a result of the disposal of the recycling and solid waste material generated from the work associated with this contract shall be handled in accordance with the procedure stated below:

If negligence in the performance of the collection work on the part of the Contractor can be documented and verified, the cost of any and all financial fines, penalties, or surcharges shall then be the exclusive responsibility of the Contractor. The burden of proof needed to determine and document negligence is the duty of the City of Brigantine. The decision of the City of Brigantine shall be final.

#### DISPOSAL LOCATION FOR RECYCLING & SOLID WASTE MATERIAL

The Contractor shall be responsible for complying with all appropriate laws, regulations, and rules with respect to collecting, loading, transporting, and unloading of recycling and solid waste material as outlined in the Atlantic County Municipal Utilities Authority (A.C.U.A.) Solid Waste Management Plan.

The Contractor shall be required to transport and unload all recycling and solid waste material in a proper and safe manner, at the approved site, as designated by the operational staff of the Atlantic County Municipal Utilities Authority.

The Contractor understands that at the time of the preparation of these specifications, the designated disposal site is Atlantic County Utilities Authority located at 6700 Delilah Rd, Egg Harbor Township, NJ 08234. However, there is a possibility that the disposal sites could change during the term of this contract. If the road mileage between Brigantine City and the new disposal site is greater than the distance currently traveled, then the Contractor and the City shall negotiate a fair change order to recognize and compensate for the additional service, and cost, not presently included in the scope of work of this contract.

The City of Brigantine reserves the right to designate another disposal facility (or facilities) in accordance with the Atlantic County Solid Waste Management Plan and/or any waste flow orders or in the event that the designated disposal facility is unable to accept waste. The City of Brigantine will assume all additional cost or benefits that are associated with such designation.

#### SUPERVISION & COMPETENCE OF PERSONNEL

The Contractor shall employ a supervisor or a foreman who shall have full authority to act for the Contractor. The Contractor shall notify the City's Contract Administrator, in writing, the name and contact information of the appointed supervisor/foreman not less than <u>thirty (30) days</u> prior to the November 13, 2018 startup date. The Contractor shall promptly notify the City's Contract Administrator, in writing, of any changes concerning this assignment.

All personnel engaged in the collection of solid waste material shall be able-bodied persons employed directly by the Contractor in accordance with all provisions of Federal, State, and Local employment laws and regulations.

All personnel shall always maintain a professional, courteous and respectful attitude towards the general public at all times.

All personnel of the Contractor shall not use abusive, vulgar, or profane language when dealing with City employees and/or members of the general public.

All personnel engaged in the execution of this contract shall be outfitted in a standard uniform, which at a minimum, requires the wearing of a company adopted or accepted shirt, which clearly indicates employment with the Contractor. Additionally, it is recommended that all personnel, while performing the collection requirements of this contract, wear a high visibility safety vest, shirt or jacket.

Absolutely, at no time shall there be any soliciting or requesting of gratuities of any type, financial and/or otherwise. Violations of this provision may result in the required termination of guilty employees. Additionally the City may assess liquidated damages against the Contractor.

Personnel engaged in the collection of solid waste material shall be adequately and sufficiently informed and educated as to what type of material is considered to be solid waste, and what material is considered to be recyclable, thus not being collected under this contract.

The Contractor's employees shall be competent in their work, and if any person shall appear incompetent or disorderly, the City of Brigantine shall notify the Contractor and specify how the employee is incompetent or disorderly. The Contractor shall take immediate steps to correct and remedy the situation to include disciplinary action, if necessary.

Employees of the Contractor, who drive or will drive a vehicle in the course of the employee's employment pursuant to the contract, shall possess a valid New Jersey driver's license for the type of vehicle operated.

#### PERMITS, LICENSES & CERTIFICATIONS

The Contractor shall be responsible for any and all necessary permits, licenses and certifications required by any governmental agency exercising statutory control over the collection, transport and disposal of solid waste materials.

#### **COMPLAINTS & CONCERNS**

The Contractor shall have personnel available from <u>8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.</u>, local time, on collection days to receive telephone calls or personal visits from City representatives relating to solid waste material collection operations. The City will anticipate that all reasonable complaints and/or concerns shall be handled in a prompt, courteous and efficient manner.

If deemed necessary by the City, the Contractor shall have a representative available to discuss complaints and concerns at the Brigantine Public Works Office located at 3605 Bayshore Ave, Brigantine, NJ 08203.

#### CONFORMANCE TO THE CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

The Public Works Director shall be at all times the sole judge as to whether the Contractor is conforming to the terms and conditions of the contract.

The Public Works Director shall be at all times the sole judge as to whether the Contractor is providing acceptable and satisfactory performance of the work associated with this contract.

The Public Works Director is the City of Brigantine's Contract Administrator of this solid waste collection contract, and as such, shall function as the City's primary contact and representative with the Contractor(s).

All requests, comments, questions, concerns, and other inquiries regarding this contract, shall be directed to or forwarded to the Director of Public Works.

Photocopies of all documents as required and mandated by these specifications shall be submitted to the City

representative at the address below. This is required in order to receive needed approval for payment of work associated with contract.

#### SPILLAGE OF SOLID WASTE MATERIAL

The Contractor shall be responsible to promptly cleanup any and all spillage (liquid or solid) that may occur, and each truck shall be equipped with a broom and a shovel, at a minimum.

Any and all spillage shall be dealt with in accordance with applicable Federal, State, and Local laws and regulations. Responsibility of notification of any and all governmental entities regarding details of reportable accidents or incidents shall rest exclusively with the Contractor.

#### DISPOSAL TIPPING FEES

The City of Brigantine will contract directly with the designated disposal facility for payment of the tipping fees for open box containers originating from the City. As such, the cost of disposal should not be included in the bidders cost proposal.

#### PERFORMANCE BOND

Notwithstanding, termination pursuant to the section, the Contractor is obligated to fully perform through the date of termination of the contract and damages shall be assessed in an amount to the costs incurred by the City of Brigantine in re-bidding the contract.

Such equal employment opportunity shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor will send to each labor union, with which it has a collective bargaining agreement, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer advising the labor union of the contractor's commitments under this chapter and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A.10:5-31 et seq. as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to meet targeted city employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personnel testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.

In conforming with the targeted employment goals, the contractor or subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey, and applicable Federal law and applicable Federal court decisions.



The contractor shall indemnify, protect, and save harmless the owner, its agents, servants, and employees from and against any and all suits, claims, losses, demands, or damages, of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of the alleged violation. The contractor shall, at its own expense, appear, defend, and pay any and all charges for legal services and any and all costs and other expenses arising from such action or administrative proceeding or incurred in connection therewith. In any and all complaints brought pursuant to the owner's grievance procedure, the contractor agrees to abide by any decision of the owner which is rendered pursuant to said grievance procedure. 
