ORDINANCE NO. 12 OF 2020

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A ONE-WAY STREET DESIGNATION FOR PORTIONS OF 11TH STREET SOUTH"

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code of the City of Brigantine (the "City") provides in Chapter 284 for certain vehicle and traffic controls; and

WHEREAS, Section 284-39, Schedule III provides for One-Way Streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brigantine believes that a portion of the 300 Block of 11th Street South should be designated as a one-way street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGANTINE IN THE COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> **§284-39. Schedule III: One-Way Streets** is amended to provide that the 300 block of 11th Street South shall be one-way in a westerly direction from the Intersection of Ocean Avenue to the Intersection of West Brigantine Avenue.

Section 2. All other provisions contained in §284-39 shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3</u>. Repealer, Severability, and Effective Date.

- A. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- B. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the City Council hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the City to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
- C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.

- Primal Waterman's Tournament *Access Permit must be displayed on front dashboard of your vehicle while you are driving, parked, or surfing in the contest zone.
- Always use proper "safe distance etiquette" with all other water sports including fishing, surfing, and swimming.
 - Keeping a safe distance means don't launch and surf right near a person fishing. Spread out to allow for proper surf fishing.

 - Keeping an eye out for swimmers in unguarded waters. Call in dangerous situations immediately.
