ORDINANCE NO. 10 OF 2022

**“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 198, SECTION
88 TO PROVIDE FOR RIBBON STYLE DRIVEWAY
SURFACING FOR RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY AND
TWO-FAMILY DWELLINGS”**

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code of the City of Brigantine (the “City”) in Chapter 198, referred to as the “Municipal Land Use Ordinance of the City of Brigantine” guides the use and development of all the lands of the City of Brigantine; and

WHEREAS, Section 198-88, Standard improvements, sets forth the requirements for all off-street parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brigantine wishes to amend the requirements in Section 198-88 to permit ribbon style driveways comprised of hard surface material divided by grass or other permeable materials for residential single-family and two-family dwellings.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF BRIGANTINE IN THE COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. **§198-88. Standard improvements** is hereby amended as follows:

- A. Surfacing. All parking spaces, driveways and aisles shall be paved with a dustless durable, asphaltic or portland concrete all-weather surface or as approved by the Municipal Engineer.
- (1) Residential single-family and two-family dwellings are permitted to provide ribbons of hard surface material divided by grass or other permeable materials in order to allow more absorption of stormwater runoff.

Section 2. All other provisions contained in §198-88 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealer, Severability, and Effective Date.

- A. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- B. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the City Council hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance

not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the City to meet the goals of the Ordinance.

- C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.

WHEREAS, the ACIA has entered into Shared Services Agreements with Participating Municipalities in Atlantic County regarding the services for registering and tracking vacant and abandoned properties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brigantine and the ACIA entered into a Shared Services Agreement dated January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2025 for the referenced property registration services; and

WHEREAS, legislation enacted by the New Jersey State Legislature and signed into law on January 18, 2022, pursuant to Chapter 444 of P.L. 2021 confirms the authority of the property registration program, and also requires certain changes to the manner in which such programs are administered; and

WHEREAS, in light of the enactment of Chapter 444 of P.L. of 2021, the Shared Services Agreement between the ACIA and the City of Brigantine will need to be modified to comply with this new law; and

WHEREAS, the City and the ACIA wish to enter into the attached First Amendment to Shared Services Agreement in the form as substantially attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Brigantine that the Mayor, City Manager and the City Clerk are authorized to execute the attached First Amendment to Shared Services Agreement Regarding Property Registration.

WHEREAS, Title 43 of the New Jersey Statutes, more specifically N.J.S.A. 43:13-23 et seq., provides that Cities of the Fourth Class (pursuant to definitions in the New Jersey statutes) such as the City of Brigantine may establish pension programs and plans for Lifeguards in their employ; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brigantine has adopted Resolution No. 86-210 and resolution No. 87-105 to comply with N.J.S.A. 43:13-23 et seq., and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 43-13-28 et seq., provides that the Mayor or Chief Executive Officer shall appoint, with the advice and consent of the members of City Council of the City of Brigantine, a Lifeguard Pension Commission of four members. One member shall be a superior officer of the life guard force, one a life guard and two citizens who are not members of the force. They shall serve for a term of four years and until their successors are appointed and have qualified and shall not receive any compensation for their services. Each person so appointed shall take an oath of office before the Mayor or other Chief Executive Officer of the City of Brigantine that he will faithfully discharge the duties of his office.
