ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_ OF 2022**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 241-7, ARTICLE I OF  
THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BRIGANTINE  
DESIGNATING THE SKATE PARK AS AN UNSUPERVISED  
FACILITY AND ESTABLISHING THE ASSOCIATED RULES FOR  
THE PARK**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brigantine intends to reconstruct the skate park which is located at the 42<sup>nd</sup> Street South Recreation Complex; and

**WHEREAS**, the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund requires its members to accept and determine by ordinance whether skate parks are supervised or unsupervised; and

**WHEREAS**, the rules for operation and use of the skate park are also to be established by ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of the City of Brigantine in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that the skate park will be operated as an UNSUPERVISED facility; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that the following rules are established. Signs which recite the rules and regulations for use of the Facility shall be posted at the entrance and at least one conspicuous place inside the facility.

1. The skate park will be used for skateboards only.
2. All users are required to wear shoes, helmets, knee pads, wrist guards, and elbow pads. All equipment must be worn to the manufacturer's specifications.
3. No food or glass containers are permitted. No pets are permitted.
4. Use of personally owned ramps, boxes, rails or other similar items is prohibited.
5. The use of alcohol, drugs and tobacco are prohibited. Additionally, profanity, abusive language, and vandalism are prohibited. Violations may result in expulsion from the facility and be further subjected to any and all penalties provided by law.
6. Backpacks, bags, jackets, and other articles of clothing and personal belongings must be placed in an appropriate area and away from the area where people skate, to avoid the possibility of injury.

7. Skateboarding and inline skating are prohibited on City property surrounding the skate park; for example, the Community Education and Recreation grounds, sidewalks and parking lots.
8. The City suggests that a parent or guardian accompany children under the age of twelve (12) when skating in the skate park.
9. The skatepark will be open daily from dawn to dusk and shall only be used during open hours. The City reserves the right to close the skate park at any time, at its discretion.
10. The skate park will be closed when weather is inclement. No skateboarding shall be permitted when the equipment is wet or icy.
11. The skate park will be closed when equipment is damaged or for routine maintenance.
12. Any organization wishing to use the skate park for an event must receive prior written approval from the City Manager's Office.

**WHEREAS**, Emergency Vehicle Services has supplied these services the past twenty years; and

**WHEREAS**, Paul Fuller, Fire Department Captain and Dennis Krause, QPA, City Purchasing Agent have reviewed the required maintenance schedules and recommended that Emergency Vehicle Services, 92 South Main Street, Mullica Hill, NJ 08062 be awarded an alternative non-advertised method for service and repairs to fire apparatus as determined by the needs of the City of Brigantine; and

**WHEREAS**, Emergency Vehicle Services has completed and submitted a Business Registration Certificate (BRC) and a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Emergency Vehicle Services has not made any contributions to a political or candidate committee for an elected office in the City of Brigantine in the previous one year period, and will prohibit them from making any contributions through the projected time of completion; and

**WHEREAS**, the vendor has provided information demonstrating its compliance with the provisions of N.J.S.A.19:44A-20.5, regarding political contributions; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Municipal Council of the City of Brigantine, New Jersey that an alternative method award with Emergency Vehicle Services for service and repairs to fire apparatus.
