ACUA will no longer empty drums and barrels of any size for recycling, trash or yard waste. Full container weight limit is **50 lbs** (excluding wheeled/lidded carts)

## DISPOSAL INFORMATION

- Bulky Waste:** 2 items per trash day including furniture & carpet. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled & tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item). No construction waste, TVs, electronics, metals or appliances.
- Metals & Appliances:** May be dropped off at Brigantine Public Works at 3605 Bayshore Avenue. Call (609) 266-7800 for details.
- Electronics:** Electronics must be dropped off at the Public Works Yard, 3605 Bayshore Avenue. ACUA does not accept electronics.
- Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://acua.com/paint)
- Shredded Paper:** Shredded paper cannot be collected curbside, but it can be recycled at ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. [acua.com/rcdropoffs](http://acua.com/rcdropoffs)
- Batteries:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, silver-oxide, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, & lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste drop-offs. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)

## YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Wednesdays, Thursdays or Fridays from 4/7/2021 until 10/8/2021

**Yard waste includes the following items:**

**leaves, grass, brush, branches, clean wood, Christmas trees**

- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
- No plastic bags.
- Place yard waste in kraft bags or in properly marked containers.
- Bags or containers should not exceed 50 lbs.
- Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
- Brush/branches should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter
