

Memorial Bench and Bicycle Rack Program

The City of Brigantine is excited to announce that the Memorial Bench Program will resume, and it will be expanded to include memorial bicycle racks. This donation program is a meaningful way to pay tribute to loved ones and honor friends while enhancing our community.

Opportunities to participate in this program will be offered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Your donation will include the installation of a 6-foot recycled material bench or a 6-foot recycled material bicycle rack, complete with a memorial plaque. The recycled materials used to construct these benches and bicycle racks are much better suited to withstand the salt air and elements, than the benches that were formerly used. Donors will now have the option to request a location for placement of their bench or rack. The City will do their best to accommodate these requests (with public safety taken into consideration). The previous Memorial Bench Program was limited to placement on the Sea Wall, however donors may now request various locations around the island such as favorite beach entrances or recreational facilities and fields, in addition to the traditional Sea Wall placement.

Anyone wishing to dedicate a bench or bicycle rack is invited to fill out an application for review. Applications are available at the Brigantine Community Center (265 42nd Street South), Brigantine City Hall (1417 West Brigantine Avenue), or Brigantine Department of Public Works (3605 Bayshore Avenue).
