RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BRIGANTINE AND THE BRIGANTINE BIBLE CHURCH REGARDING THE CHURCH'S USE OF 100 BAYSHORE AVENUE FOR OVERFLOW PARKING DURING SUNDAY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Brigantine ("City") owns certain real property known as 100 Bayshore Avenue, Brigantine, New Jersey, described on the Tax Map of the City of Brigantine as Block 6901, Lot 1 herein referred to as (the "Property"), which the City uses for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Brigantine Bible Church, 103 Bayshore Avenue, Brigantine, New Jersey, which is located across the street from the Property, has requested City officials for permission to use the Property, specifically the strip of grass that abuts 104 Bayshore Avenue as depicted on Exhibit "A", as an overflow parking area for the Brigantine Bible Church Congregation during the hours of Church services on Sunday; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brigantine ("City Council") has recognized the need for additional parking and has explored ways to increase available parking in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement to outline the Brigantine Bible Church's use of the Parking Area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it to be in the City's best interest to execute an Agreement with the Brigantine Bible Church to help ease the Church's parking concerns with no additional costs to the City, its residents, or its visitors; and

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement shall be for 3 years from June 14, 2024 to June 14, 2027 with the option to renew the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Brigantine, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that:

- 1) The City Manager is authorized to execute the Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement with the Brigantine Bible Church allowing the Church to use the Parking Area, located within the Property, for overflow parking during the hours of Church services on Sunday.
- 2) The City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to execute any and all documents in furtherance of this Resolution upon review and approval of such documents by the City Solicitor's Office.
