



CITY OF BRIGANTINE YARD

The yard is available to all City residents, free of charge.

Location: 3605 Bayshore Ave, behind the Public Works Building

Normal hours of operation: 7:00am-4:20pm, 7 days a week (closed some holiday's)

The following items are accepted at the yard:

Regular household trash, paper & cardboard, Plastics #1, #2, #5 (bottles, containers, jugs), metal cans, glass bottles/jars, grass clippings, clothing, metal appliances.

(Each item listed above has its own container for disposal)

The following Electronic Waste are accepted at the yard:

Electronic waste such as AC adapters, all-in-one computers, aluminum, brass, light iron and copper, ballasts (non-PBC's), car batteries, cash registers, cell phones & telephones, computer monitors, computer periphery and parts, e-readers, game consoles, gold slip ends, handheld/table mounted scanners, hard drives, microwave ovens, motherboards, motors, MP3 players, PC's fan and power supplies, PC desktop, laptops, tablets, towers, police scanners, portable radios, printers/copiers/scanners, scales, televisions, toner cartridges, uninterrupted power supply, VCR/DVD, wires all types, hoverboards, cell phones, lead acid batteries.

The following items are not accepted at the yard:

Rechargeable batteries, household batteries, cooking oil, automotive oil, concrete, asphalt, tires, wood, construction debris (sheds, flooring, molding, lumber, shingles, sheetrock, cabinets, counter tops, etc.), yard waste, tree stumps/logs, paint, hazardous waste.

Bulk Pickup offered by ACUA:

ACUA will allow 2 bulk items for pick up each week, most large items that cannot fit into your regular trash can are considered bulky waste, examples: mattresses, most furniture, carpeting (must be bundled and tied into 4' lengths, 1 roll = 1 item)

White Good's pickup offered by the City:

The City of Brigantine is more than happy to help with the disposal of appliances, please call the Department of Public Works to schedule the appliance pick up on your normal trash day, please have it out at the curb no later that 7:00am on the day of scheduled pick up.

At NO time will contractors or vehicles/trailers with commercial plates be allowed to access the yard.
